### Total Costing for the PPL - 4 Seat Aircraft

The PPL consists of:

45 hours flying time (Minimum).

Cost: 45 hrs @ £153.19 = £6,893.55

This figure includes flying instruction, pre-flight briefings, all landing fees at Cranfield, VAT and fuel charges.

The following are not included:

7 written exams and 1 practical test:

As part of the course you will land at other airfields.

The landing fees at other airfields will vary, but typically you can expect to pay in the region of £10 per landing.

There are likely to be about 7 landings during the course which will cost: £70.00

Note: All landing fees at Cranfield are included in the hourly rate of the flying

Membership Fee £80.00

A CAA Class 2 Medical is required before going solo. Typical cost is: £150.00

Lastly there is the Flight Test & License Issue.

Flight Test approximately 2 hours @ £140.00 ph = £280.00  
Test Fee: £150.00

CAA License issue fee is: £168.00

Based on the above figures you can expect the total cost for the PPL to be: £8,216.55
